

LLVM FOUNDATION GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION FOR TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GRANTS

Purpose

LLVM Foundation (the “Foundation”) is committed to diversity in the fields of computer science and engineering. As part of its commitment to diversity, the Foundation provides travel reimbursement to deserving individuals attending LLVM Developers’ Meetings or other compilers and tools related educational conferences.

Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a current undergraduate or graduate student.
- Not be a Foundation director, officer, or employee, or relative of any Foundation director, officer, or employee.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship recipients are selected based on the following criteria:

- Financial need
- Current research or academic work with the LLVM project
- Participation with the LLVM Project or relevant work experience
- Priority is given to those presenting a paper/work using LLVM or related sub-project at the conference/workshop.
- Priority may be given to women or minority students in order to encourage broader representation of women and minorities in computer science and engineering.

Selection Process

- Applications will be accepted until the first of each month as long as budgeted funds are available.
- Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information on the Application form. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- All information received from the applicant will be treated as confidential and will not be shared outside of the Foundation except as required by governmental regulations such as IRS reviews of the Foundation’s Grant Program.
- Successful applicants will be notified by the 15th day of the application deadline month and will be given a grant letter, to be signed and returned to the selection committee before funds are disbursed.

Award Amounts

The number and amount of individual awards may vary from year to year.

Payment

Successful applicants will be required to submit receipts and supporting documentation to the Foundation within 30 days of incurring the expense. Reimbursements shall not be made prior to the Foundation receiving all supporting documentation. Payments will be made payable to the recipient or the recipient's legal guardian and directed to the recipient's home address.
